**Program:** John W. Seiler, Vice President, Premier Relationship Manager HSBC USA NA(30 Danbury Road Wilton, CT 06897) addressed the club.

John's focus was on how can HSBC help the Rotary club of Wilton serve the community. More than \$ 20,000 was contributed to Wilton in 1008 – 2009 may not be quite as robust in terms of contributions but there are other ways to help and John is considering Richard Kent's request for a venue for a club sponsored summer concert. HSBC was founded in 1865 in Hong Kong (stands for Hong Kong Shanghai Bancorp). The bank is HQ'd in London now. 82 countries and 12,000 locations. It appears that HSBC will not be opening any new retail branches in Connecticut in the near future given the overall financial climate.
