First Selectwoman Vanderslice discussed recent commercial construction that has contributed to the growth of the Wilton Grand List; issues with the respect to the Town's infrastructure, including the Town's buildings; the status and results of the reevaluation of the value of real estate; and expected challenges to the 2020 Town budget. Selectwoman Vanderslice also discussed the several bills that have been proposed in the CT legislature that would require certain towns to combine their school districts with adjoining towns, including one bill that would require Wilton to merge with the Norwalk school district.
